The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed the U.S. Air Force Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) in accordance with our responsibilities under Section 102(2)(C) of the National Environmental Policy Act and Section 309 of the Clean Air Act. The purposed project involves the beddown of the F-35A Wing and possibly a MQ-9 Operational Wing at Tyndall Air Force Base (AFB), Florida, or an alternate beddown location for the MQ-9 Remote Piloted Aircraft at Vandenburg AFB, California.

The U.S. Air Force (USAF) selected Tyndall AFB Florida as its preferred alternative for the beddown of both the F-35 and the MQ-9 Operational Wing. Based on our review of the FEIS, the EPA has no environmental concerns regarding the overall scope of this proposed project. In addition, our previously identified concerns have been addressed, specifically noise mitigations measures considered in Section 2.7.1. of the FEIS. Nevertheless, we encourage the USAF to continue to seek measures to further avoid and minimize potential noise impacts on nearby communities and the environment. We also request an electronic copy of the record of decision, when it becomes available.
